## INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

- Download the template:

- The manuscripts must be original.
- The texts received will be anonymously refereed by at least two experts with an affinity for the specialty or field of stud. Our refereeing system uses evaluators external to the Instituto Tecnológico Superior Universitario Rumiñahui to avoid conflicts of interest.
- Manuscripts should be submitted in Word for Windows; the kind of font is Times New Roman, font size 12 pts.; the line spacing should be 1.5, with space between paragraphs six and with the margins as follows: top and bottom 2.5 cm and left and right 2.5 cm.
- Manuscripts for scientific articles should be between 12 and 20 pages long, including tables and figures. Review articles should be at least 20 pages long, including tables and figures. In both cases, references are not included.
- If the text includes charts, figures, images, and maps, they must be in the format's jpg, png, or tiff, with a higher resolution of 500 dpi.
- Figures and tables should be incorporated with Arabic numbering and referred to in the text before or after.
- Commitments of the authors: Originality and fidelity of the data: The authors of papers submitted to the Journal Connectivity state that the work is original and unpublished, has not been presented at other scientific journal or publication character or non-academic, which does not contain parts of other works and/or other authors had previously published. In addition, confirm the veracity of the data, that is to say, that it has not been altered or invented data to comply with the hypothesis.
- Attributions, citations, and references: The author must always indicate the source and contributions mentioned in the article.
- Authorship: The authors warrant the inclusion of those individuals who have made significant contributions to the planning, development, and obtaining of the research results and writing a scientific article. In the same way, we must prioritize the order of appearance of the authors according to their level of responsibility and involvement. Although the magazine Connectivity does not have a maximum allowable number of authors, it is recommended that this not exceed 5.
- Access and retention: If the members of the Editorial Committee consider it necessary, the authors of the articles must make available sources and information based on the research, which can be kept for a reasonable period after the publication and possibly become accessible.

- Conflict of interest and disclosure: All authors are required to declare explicitly that they have no conflicts of interest that might have influenced the results obtained and the interpretations proposed.
- Errors in the published articles: When an author identifies a significant error or inaccuracy in his article, you must immediately inform the journal editors and provide them with all the information required to make the relevant corrections.
- Responsibility: The authors are not responsible for the content of the articles published in the Journal Conectividad. The authors also review the scientific literature more current and relevant to the topic discussed.
- The texts must be submitted in the following order:

**The header of the manuscript:**

The title of the article, in both Spanish and English, should be concise and clear, with a maximum of 20 words.

Name of author or authors, in the following order: first name, last name, affiliation institutional, ORCI, e-mail, city and country.

Abstracts in two languages, Spanish and English (including, in each summary, keywords in the respective languages), should be at most 200 words.

Keywords in two languages, Spanish and English, are separated by semicolons; they must include a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 5.

**Content of the manuscript**

**1. Introduction**

The introduction informs three essential elements of the research: the purpose, the importance, and the current knowledge of the topic. It describes the interest in the topic chosen and its importance in the scientific context of the time.

**2. Materials and methods**

This section explains the steps and tools used to reach the results. Describe the research design and explain how it led to the practice, justifying the methods and techniques employed. Submit the description according to the sequence following the research design, population and sample, variables, data collection, analysis, and other elements the author considers necessary.

**3. Results and discussion**

They can go together or separately. You should include tables and/or figures to be the case, which the author must indicate by a parenthesis of its location in the article. The

discussion should end with a comment highlighting the importance of the results obtained.

#### **4. Conclusions**

The findings summarize the author's contribution of knowledge to the world. The generalizations about the research process are theoretical.

#### **Bibliographic references (corresponding to the appointments explicit in the text).**

They must be written in APA 7th edition style, preferably from the last 5 years, and a minimum of 12 for scientific articles and 30 for review articles.
